SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 83836 dated December 17, 1974 in Application No. 51774 and related matters, General Telephone Company of California was ordered to refund approximately \$1 million to its customers by means of a uniform credit, such credit to be completed at the end of one billing cycle of approximately 30 days.

General Telephone informs us that it will require an additional 15 days to begin its billing cycle because of technical difficulties. ✓

Therefore, good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that the time in which General Telephone Company of California may begin its refund is extended to February 1, 1975. ✓
