ORDER OF SUSPENSION AND INVESTIGATION

Industrial Communications Systems, Inc. having filed on December 5, 1974, under Advice Letter No. 60, certain tariff sheets providing for establishment of an additional transmitter to be located at 11640 Anderson Street, Loma Linda, California, protests having been received December 20, 1974, and the Commission being of the opinion that the effective date of each of the tariff sheets should be postponed pending completion of the investigation, hearing, and decision thereon now in progress; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The investigation order by Order of Suspension and Investigation, filed April 2, 1974, and designated as Case No. 9696, be continued.
2. The operations and effectiveness of the rates, classification, practices, or rules in the tariffs filed by Advice Letter No. 60 are hereby suspended to and including May 5, 1975, unless otherwise hereafter ordered.
3. The suspension of Advice Letter No. 60 shall be heard at the same time and place as the suspension of Advice Letter No. 50, February 4, 5, and 6, 1975, at Loma Linda, California.
4. Advice Letter No. 60 and Advice Letter No. 50 are consolidated for all purposes.

The Secretary of the Commission is directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be served forthwith on Industrial Communications Systems, Inc. and to send copies to Intrastate Radiotelephone, Inc. of San Bernardino and Radio Dispatch Corporation.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.
