ORDER DISMISSING APPLICATION NO. 54839

The above proceedings all concern various aspects of specialized private telephone line service.

The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company (Pacific Telephone) filed Application No. 55344 to replace Application No. 54839. Pacific Telephone, through its counsel at the hearing on December 11, 1974, requested that Application No. 55344 be consolidated with the remaining proceedings and that Application No. 54839 be dismissed.

The examiner, after adjusting the hearing schedule to allow for adequate discovery regarding the new application (No. 55344), ordered it consolidated with the remaining proceedings.

We find that Application No. 54839 should now be dismissed.

IT IS ORDERED that Application No. 54839 is dismissed.
