ORDER OF DISMISSAL

By letter dated November 27, 1974 the Commission advised Southern Pacific Transportation Company, the successor to Southern Pacific Company (Southern Pacific), that Application No. 49251 might be dismissed without prejudice for lack of prosecution unless on or before December 16, 1974 Southern Pacific submitted a request for dismissal or submitted in writing good reasons why the application should not be dismissed. No written response to this letter has been made by Southern Pacific.

By letter dated December 17, 1974 Southern California Rapid Transit District requested that Application No. 49751 be dismissed without prejudice.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that Applications Nos. 49251 and 49751 are dismissed without prejudice.
