ORDER EXTENDING TIME

The Commission on January 2, 1975 received a written request, by letter dated November 25, 1974, from Francis H. Ferraro for a further extension of time of one year of the final date of December 11, 1974 to comply with Ordering Paragraph 1 of Decision No. 73361, issued herein on November 21, 1967.

In the letter Mr. Ferraro states that the authorized transfer has not been completed, although an Appellate District Court has decreed in his favor. The case has been remanded to the Superior Court to determine how the contract between Mr. Bird and him is to be specifically enforced. The time involved in the next step of the court's action is unknown.

The Commission having considered the request from Francis H. Ferraro and finding it reasonable,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the first line of paragraph 1 of the order in Decision No. 73361, issued herein on November 21, 1967, is further revised to read:

"1. On or before December 11, 1975,..."

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.
