SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER By Decision No. 83552 dated October 8, 1974, in this proceeding, California Cartage Company, Inc. was granted an in-lieu highway common carrier authority. Applicant's attorney, by letter dated January 16, 1975, alleges that the application inadvertently failed to exclude the transportation of campers and trailers from the proposed service and requests that the certificate of public convenience and necessity that was issued in this proceeding be amended accordingly. Applicant also requests an extension of time to initiate the authorized service and to file amended tariffs. In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that the request should be granted. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the extension of time should be granted and Appendix A of Decision No. 83552, supra, should be amended. IT IS ORDERED that the time to initiate the authorized service and to file the amended tariffs is extended to June 15, 1975 and that Appendix A of Decision No. 83552 is amended by incorporating First Revised Page 2, attached hereto, in revision of Original Page 2.

Except that pursuant to the authority herein granted, carrier shall not transport any shipments of:

Livestock; uncrated used household goods and office furniture; commodities requiring special equipment; commodities in bulk; articles of extraordinary value; explosives; commodities injurious or contaminating to other lading; or trailer coaches and campers, including integral parts and contents when the contents are within the trailer coach or camper.

Uncrated means not securely packed in salesmen's hand sample cases, suitcases, overnight or boston bags, brief cases, hat boxes, valises, traveling bags, trunks, lift vans, barrels, boxes, cartons, crates, cases, baskets, pails, kits, tubs, drums, bags (jute cotton, burlap or gunny) or bundles (completely wrapped in jute, cotton burlap, gunny, fibreboard, or straw matting).
