THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

1. All increased revenues collected by General
Telephone Company of California pursuant to Decision No. 83779
and subsequent to the effective date of this order shall be
collected subject to refund pending review of Decision No. 83779
by the California Supreme Court and until further order of the
Commission.

2. General Telephone Company of California shall,
after the effective date of this order, maintain records of
intrastate charges to each of its customers (excluding coin box
collections) pending review of Decision No. 83779 by the California
Supreme Court and until further order of the Commission.
