ORDER REVOKING MAREMOUSE OPERATIVE RIGHT

Sutter Basin Growers Cooperative, a corporation, possesses a certificate of public convenience and necessity as a public utility warehouseman for the operation of storage or warehouse floor space at Knights Landing.

Ray C. Warner, Assistant Secretary - Manager of Sutter Dasin Growers Cooperative, has notified the Commission by letter that the utility is no longer engaged in the public storage business and is now operating as a bonded warehouse under the License No. 1-209 issued by the United States Department of Agriculture pursuant to the United States Warehouse Act. He requests that the operative right be revoked.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that revocation of the warehouse operative right, as requested, would not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the operative right should be revoked and the tariff or tariffs applicable to the service thereunder should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. The certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a public utility warehouseman granted to Sutter Basin Growers Cooperative, a corporation, by Decision No. 74690 dated September 17, 1968, in Application No. 50418 is hereby revoked.
- 2. Jack L. Dawson, Agent, is hereby directed to cancel the participation of Sutter Basin Growers Cooperative from the involved

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tariff or tariffs of California Warehouse Tariff Bureau on file with the Commission, such cancellation to be made within ninety days after the effective date of this order and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Sutter Dasin Growers Cooperative or to mail a certified copy thereof to it at its last known address as shown in the Commission's records and to mail a copy of this order to Jack L. Dawson, Agent.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
