## ORDER REVOKING WAREHOUSE OPERATIVE RIGHT

Shifflet Bros., Inc., a corporation, possesses a prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman for the operation of storage or warehouse floor space at Chico.

Donald Shifflet, on behalf of the corporation, has informed the Commission by letter that the utility has not engaged in public storage since the early part of 1973. He requests that the operative right be revoked.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that revocation of the prescriptive operative right, as requested, would not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the operative right should be revoked and the tariff applicable to the services thereunder should be canceled.

## IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman acquired by Shifflet Bros., Inc., by Decision No. 73096 dated September 19, 1967, in Application No. 49623, is hereby revoked.

2. C. R. Nickerson, Agent, is hereby authorized and directed to cancel the participation of Shifflet Bros., Inc., from the involved tariff of Pacific Coast Tariff Bureau on file with the Commission, such cancellation to be made within 90 days after the effective date of this order and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Shifflet Bros., Inc., or to mail a certified copy thereof to it at its last known address as shown in the Commission's records and to mail a copy of this order to C. R. Nickerson, Agent.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
