ORDER RELIEVING CARRIER FROM FURTHER
COMPLIANCE WITH DECISION NO. 82052 IN CASE NO. 9550

By order effective November 22, 1973 in Decision No. 82052, respondent Anna Mann as executrix of the estate of Elwin R. Mann, deceased, doing business as Elwin R. Mann Transportation, was directed to take such action, including legal action, as may be necessary to collect the undercharges set forth in Finding 8 of the order. Respondent Mann was further directed to proceed promptly, diligently and in good faith to pursue all reasonable measures to collect the undercharges and to report to the Commission the undercharges remaining to be collected, specifying the action taken to collect such undercharges and the result of such action until the undercharges have been collected in full, or until further order of the Commission.

Respondent Mann, presently incorporated as Mann Transportation, Inc., having petitioned the Commission by letter dated January 27, 1975, to be relieved from the obligation of collecting undercharges from Richard C. Schwartz & Co., Los Angeles, California, in the amount of \$1,066.33, the Commission having thoroughly considered said request and good cause appearing;

IT IS ORDERED that:

Mann Transportation, Inc., a corporation, is hereby released and relieved from any obligation or duty arising from any directives heretofore given by the Commission to collect the undercharges arising from transportation performed for R. C. Schwartz & Co. during the period November 23, 1971 to and including March 25, 1972.
