ORDER EXTENDING TIME

Decision No. 83398 dated December 30, 1974 authorized a sale and transfer of certain operative rights on or before February 3, 1975. The decision required that tariff filings be effective concurrently with the transfer of operative rights.

Counsel for Wagner Distribution Services, Inc. requests that the transfer and filing date be extended from February 3, 1975 to March 1, 1975. Wagner Distribution Services, Inc. was unable to meet the February 3, 1975 deadline.

The request is reasonable. A public hearing is not necessary. Because of the time required to process this request we will extend time until March 28, 1975.
