ORDER GRANTING
REHEARING AND STAY

On February 19, 1975 the Commission issued Decision No. 84130 deleting the authority of Pacific Southwest Airlines (PSA) to operate nonstop air carrier service between Hollywood-Burbank and Sacramento.
