ORDER CHANGING EFFECTIVE DATE

In Decision No. 84193 dated March 18, 1975 the Commission ordered certain changes in Minimum Rate Tariffs 19 and 1-B in addition to changes in certain common carrier tariffs. The effective date of Decision No. 84193 was made to be twenty days after March 18, 1975, on April 7, 1975. The ordering paragraphs of Decision No. 84193 made the required tariff filings effective April 4, 1975. This discrepancy, if not corrected, will cause problems in tariff interpretation and enforcement.
