ORDER REVOKING WAREHOUSE OPERATIVE RIGHT

Pacific International Rice Mills, Inc., a corporation, possesses a certificate of public convenience and necessity as a public utility warehouseman for the operation of storage or warehouse floor space at Woodland and Robbins.

Hugh M. Nicol, Vice President of the corporation, has informed the Commission by letter that the utility is no longer engaged in the public storage business at the above locations and is now operating as a bonded warehouse at said locations under License No. 3-5279 issued by the United States Department of Agriculture pursuant to the United States Warehouse Act. He requests that the certificate be revoked.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that revocation of the warehouse operative right, as requested, would not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the operative right should be revoked and the tariff applicable to the services thereunder should be cancelled.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The certificate of public convenience and necessity as a public utility warehouseman granted to Pacific International Rice Mills, Inc., a corporation, by Decision No. 83091, as amended by Decisions Nos. 83212 and 83424, in Application No. 54911 is hereby revoked.

2. Jack L. Dawson, Agent, is hereby directed to cancel the participation of Pacific International Rice Mills, Inc., from the involved California Warehouse Tariff Bureau tariff on file with the Commission, such cancellation to be made within ninety days after the effective date of this order on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Pacific International Rice Mills, Inc. or to mail a certified copy thereof to it at its last known address as shown in the Commission's records and to mail a copy of this order to Jack L. Dawson, Agent.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
