ORDER EXTENDING TIME

By Decisions Nos. 83216 dated July 30, 1974 and 83232 dated August 6, 1974, Data Transportation Co., Inc. was authorized to operate as a public utility warehouseman in the cities of Vernon and San Jose, respectively. By Decisions Nos. 83877 and 83878 dated December 17, 1974, the time within which to file tariffs, in compliance with the ordering paragraphs of said decisions, was continued to April 1, 1975.
