ORDER EXTENDING TIME AND ORDER OF MODIFICATION

By letter applicant requests an extension of time for the consummation of the sale and transfer of operative rights. The request is made because the Interstate Commerce Commission has not processed its decision, and applicant would prefer that the transfer be concurrent with the interstate authority.

Applicant further requests that paragraph 3 of the order in Decision No. 84018 be amended to delete reference to Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc. and the condition that the purchaser be required to reinstate and update the seller's tariff filings with said Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc. The deletion might result in some minor increases, therefore, we find that any increases resulting from this proposal are justified.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Decision No. 84018 is modified to the extent that the time for applicant to consummate the sale and transfer of operative rights is extended for one hundred twenty days after the effective date hereof.

2. Paragraph 3 of the order in Decision No. 84018 is amended to read as follows:

3. Purchaser shall, within one hundred twenty days after the effective date hereof, establish the service herein authorized and file tariffs. Tariff filings shall be made in the Commission's office in triplicate. The tariff filings shall be made effective not earlier than five days after the effective date of this order on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public, and the effective date of the tariff filings shall be concurrent with the transfer. The tariff filings made pursuant to this order shall comply in all respects with the regulations governing the construction and filing of tariffs set forth in the Commission's General Order No. 80-Series. Failure to comply with the provisions of General Order No. 80-Series may result in a cancellation of the operating authority granted by this decision.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.
