ORDER EXTENDING EFFECTIVE DATE

Decision No. 84334 dated April 15, 1975 in Case No. 9263 modified the Uniform Water Main Extension Rule in regard to extensions designed to include fire protection. The effective date of the order was to be twenty days after April 15, 1975.

Respondent California Water Association requests a thirty-day extension of the effective date so that it might have additional time to obtain the views of its members on the changes caused by Decision No. 84334 to determine if a Petition for Rehearing should be filed.
