ORDER REVOKING WAREHOUSE OPERATIVE RIGHT

James Balsdon, Francis Wilmarth, Carolyn Hiller and H. H. Balsdon, doing business as Graino Elevator Company, possess a prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman for the operation of storage or warehouse floor space at Grimes and vicinity in Colusa County.

Harold Wilsey, Jr., attorney for the partnership, has informed the Commission by letter that the partnership is no longer engaged in the public utility warehouse business as the partners have been storing only their own commodities for some time. He requests that the operative right be revoked.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that revocation of the prescriptive operative right, as requested, would not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the operative right should be revoked and the tariff applicable to the services thereunder should be canceled.

## IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman possessed by James Balsdon, Francis Wilmarth, Carolyn Hiller and H. H. Balsdon, doing business as Graino Elevator Company, as determined by the Commission's order dated June 14, 1960 in Case No. 6531, is hereby revoked.

2. Jack L. Dawson, Agent, is hereby directed to cancel the participation of James Balsdon, Francis Wilmarth, Carolyn Hiller.

and H. H. Balsdon, doing business as Graino Elevator Company, from the involved tariff of California Warehouse Tariff Bureau on file with the Commission, such cancellation to be made within 90 days after the effective date of this order and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon James Balsdon, Francis Wilmarth, Carolyn Hiller and H. H. Balsdon or to mail a certified copy thereof to them at their last known address as shown in the Commission's records and to mail a copy of this order to Jack L. Dawson, Agent.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
