ORDER EXTENDING PERIOD OF SUSPENSION

By an order of suspension and investigation, issued December 30, 1974, certain tariff sheets filed under Advice Letter No. 60 by Industrial Communications Systems, Inc. were suspended until May 5, 1975, pending public hearing and further order of the Commission. It appears that conclusion of the matter may not be accomplished by May 5, 1975.
