ORDER OF SUSPENSION

The Commission having received a request for suspension of Decision No. 83779 insofar as it authorizes timed message rate business service; and

Said timed message rate business service being scheduled to become effective on May 1, 1975, pursuant to tariffs filed March 27, 1975 under Advice Letter No. 3329; and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. General Telephone Company of California tariffs pertaining to timed message rate business service are hereby suspended until further order of the Commission.

2. Decision No. 83779 is hereby suspended insofar as it authorizes timed message rate business service.


3. Along with the regular bills, General Telephone Company of California shall furnish each flat rate business customer with an information statement indicating what charges for telephone service would have been applicable had the timed message rate business service been in effect as of May 1, 1975.

4. Hearings in this matter will be held at such time and place and before such Commissioner or Examiner as the Commission shall designate.

5. In all other respects Decision No. 83779 shall remain in full force and effect.

Because of the imminent effective date of the applicable tariffs, the effective date of this order is the date hereof.
