ORDER REVOKING WAREHOUSE OPERATIVE RIGHT

Glenn Growers, a corporation, possesses a prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman for the operation of storage or warehouse floor space at Codora Station in Glenn County.

Harry Jones, Secretary-Treasurer of the corporation, has informed the Commission by letter that the utility has not engaged in the public storage business since September 12, 1974, the date it commenced operations as a bonded warehouse under License No. 3-6358 issued by the United States Department of Agriculture pursuant to the United States Warehouse Act. He requests that the operative right be revoked.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that revocation of the prescriptive operative right, as requested, would not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the warehouse operative right should be revoked and that the tariff applicable to the services thereunder should be cancelled.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman possessed by Glenn Growers, a corporation, as determined by the Commission's order dated August 23, 1960, in Case No. 6878, is hereby revoked.

2. Jack L. Dawson, Agent, is hereby directed to cancel the participation of Glenn Growers from the involved tariff of California Warehouse Tariff Bureau on file with the Commission, such cancellation to be made within 90 days after the effective date of this order on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Glenn Growers or to mail a certified copy thereof to it at its last known address as shown in the Commission's records and to mail a copy of this order to Jack L. Dawson, Agent.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
