On March 11, 1975, this Commission granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate a passenger stage corporation to Stuart Alan Messnick, dba The Co-Ordinators. By this decision, the Commission granted applicant authority to operate a passenger stage route from the Buena Park-Anaheim-Santa Ana area to San Ysidro for the purpose of conducting

tours in the Tijuana area. On March 20, 1975, Greyhound Lines, Inc. (Western Division) filed a petition for rehearing with the Commission. The petitioner alleges that the Commission erred in not complying with Section 1032 of the Public Utilities Code.

After considering each and every allegation of petitioner, we are of the opinion that good cause for rehearing has not been shown. The Commission's findings and conclusions of law stated in Decision No. 84186 adequately considered the requirements of Section 1032 of the Public Utilities Code and properly concluded, based on the evidence that the grant of a certificate of public convenience and necessity to applicant is warranted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that rehearing of Decision No. 84186 is denied.
