## ORDER REOPENING APPLICATIONS NOS. 55459 AND 55460 AND STAYING DECISION NO. 84252

A petition for rehearing of Decision No. 84252 has been filed by Les Calkins Trucking, Inc., Earl W. Hudson, and Universal Transportation System (Petitioners). Petitioners allege that the transfers authorized by said decisions are not legally valid in that the subject certificates lapsed and terminated pursuant to Public Utilities Code, Section 1065.2.

We believe that good cause for rehearing has been shown. However, as an alternative to granting rehearing, we choose, instead, to proceed under Public Utilities Code, Section 1708.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Applications Nos. 55459 and 55460 are hereby reopened for the limited purpose of determining whether the authority to transfer as granted by Decision No. 84252 was invalid because of the provisions of Public Utilities Code, Section 1065.2. A.55459, A.55460

Pending further determination, the order 2. set forth in Decision No. 84252 is hereby stayed.
