BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of SWIFT AIR LINES, INC., a California corporation, for authorization to operate as a passenger air carrier between Sacramento, on the one hand, and Visalia and Bakersfield, on the other hand, using the latter two points as either terminal or intermediate points, via Fresno; Fresno and Bakersfield; Los Angeles, on the one hand, and Fresno, Visalia and Bakersfield, on the other hand, using the latter three points as either terminal or intermediate points; San Luis Obispo and Santa Maria, on the one hand, using both points as either terminal or intermediate points, and Bakersfield, Visalia and Fresno, on the other hand, using the latter three points as terminal or intermediate points, via Los Angeles.
