ORDER EXTENDING TIME TO FILE TARIFFS

Decision No. 83830 dated December 17, 1974 and effective twenty days thereafter granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to applicant. Ordering Paragraph 2(b) of this decision required applicant, inter alia, to amend or file tariffs within one hundred twenty days after the effective date of the order, thus making May 6, 1975 the effective date for such filing.

Applicant has informed the Commission that Western Motor Tariff Bureau was unable to make tariff publication before May 6, 1975; thus applicant has requested an extension of time to effect the filing of the necessary tariff changes in compliance with Decision No. 83830. By the same correspondence, applicant has indicated its acceptance of the certificate granted, substantially later than required in Ordering Paragraph 2(a) of this decision. There is no reason not to allow applicants late acceptance or to refuse the requested time extension.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Applicant's acceptance of the certificate granted in Decision No. 83830 is approved, though received by the Commission on April 30, 1975.

2. Leave is granted applicant to comply with the tariff filing provisions of Ordering Paragraph 2(b) of Decision No. 83830 not later than August 6, 1975.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.
