ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR REHEARING

By Decision No. 84212, issued on March 18, 1975, Smith Transportation Co. (Smith), was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to extend service to points in the San Joaquin Valley along Highway No. 5 and State Highway Nos. 145 and 99. The decision was stayed by a timely filing on March 28, 1975 of a petition for rehearing by Atlas Marine Freight Lines.

After considering each and every allegation set forth in the petition, we are of the opinion that good cause for rehearing has not been shown.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that rehearing of Decision No. 84212 is denied.
