OPINION

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company requests authority to construct a spur track at grade across Consolidated Way in the City of San Diego, County of San Diego.

Notice of the application was published in the Commission's calendar on April 16, 1975. No protests have been received. A public hearing is not necessary.

FINDINGS

After consideration, the Commission finds:

- 1. The proposed construction will provide rail service to the plant of Japatul Corporation located south of Consolidated Way.
- 2. Applicant should be authorized to construct a spur track, at grade, across Consolidated Way in the City of San Diego, County of San Diego, at the location and substantially as shown by the plan attached to the application.
- 3. Costs of constructing the crossing should be borne by the applicant.
