SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

The minimum rates for parcel delivery service set forth in Item 265 of Minimum Rate Tariff 2, Item 850 of Minimum Rate Tariff 1-B, Item 420 of Minimum Rate Tariff 9-B, and Item 425 of Minimum Rate Tariff 19 were established to meet the rates published and maintained by United Parcel Service, Inc. By Decision No. 84537, entered today, United Parcel Service, Inc. was authorized to increase certain rates and accessorial charges. The Commission finds that the aforementioned tariffs should be amended to reflect that increase in the parcel delivery rate, and that common carriers should be directed to raise their rates to the level of the rates authorized to United Parcel Service, Inc. or to the minimum rates, whichever is lower.

Tariff publications authorized and required to be made by common carriers as a result of this ordering paragraph may be made effective not earlier than the fifth day after the effective date of this order, on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public, and shall be made effective not later than thirty days after the effective date of the tariff publications made pursuant to the authority granted in Decision No. <u>84537</u>.

8. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the rates authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 461.5 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the rates published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing the long- and short-haul departures and to this order.
