ORDER OF DISMISSAL

By petition filed May 9, 1975, Western Motor Freight Bureau, Inc., on behalf of various carriers participating in its Local, Joint and Proportional Freight and Express Tariffs 109 and 111, Cal.P.U.C. Nos. 13 and 15, respectively, requests investigation and suspension of certain 40,000, 50,000 and 60,000-pound rates on "freight, not otherwise specified" between various northern California points and points in the Los Angeles Basin area as set forth in Item 11236 of Supplement 270 of Pacific Southcoast Freight Bureau Freight Tariff 300-A.

The tariff supplement was filed April 10, 1975, on statutory notice with the Commission and became effective May 14, 1975. The petition in this proceeding was filed five days before the effective date of the tariff supplement. Such filing was not in accordance with the requirements of General Order No. 113-A which provides that requests for suspension of rates published on statutory notice will not be considered unless they reach the Commission at least twelve days before the effective dates of the involved tariff filings.
