SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Airport Service, Incorporated, a corporation, by this application sought an extension of its operating authority to include service to Ontario International Airport. A new Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity was granted by Decision No. 83743, dated November 19, 1974, which included authorization of this extension.

Through inadvertence certain insertions in the Certificate were omitted, and corrections should be made in Appendix A of Decision No. 83743, as follows: (1) Original Page 6, Subparagraph (1) "... destined to L.A. International Airport or Orange County" should include "or Ontario International Airport"; (2) Original Page 12, under Route 1, third line after "Huntington Beach" should include "continuing along the Pacific Coast Highway"; and (3) Original Page 14, under Alternate Route - LAX-Mission Viejo-Laguna Hills, fourth line, the reference to "Santa Ana Freeway", should be deleted and, instead, "Interstate Highway 5" inserted therein.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Original Pages 6, 12, and 14 of the Appendix A Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity attached to Decision No. 83743 in this application are cancelled, and in their stead are adopted First Revised Pages 6, 12 and 14, attached hereto and by reference made a part hereof.

2. In all other respects, Decision No. 83743 is reaffirmed and is in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof, unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with the Commission written response to this order requesting public hearing in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.

SECTION 2. DESCRIPTION OF SERVICE TERRITORIES

Long Beach Service Area

Commencing at the junction of the San Gabriel River and Artesia Boulevard in Lakewood; thence along Artesia Boulevard, Alameda Street, Henry Ford Avenue to junction of Henry Ford Avenue and City Limits of Long Beach; thence along City Limits of Long Beach and west boundary of the U.S. Naval Base south to the ocean; thence east along the shoreline of Long Beach Harbor and Long Beach to the junction of the shoreline and outlet of the San Gabriel River; thence north along the San Gabriel River to the point of beginning.

Pasadena-Monrovia Service Area

Commencing at the intersection of Loma Alta Drive and Lincoln Avenue; thence along Lincoln Avenue, Montana Street, Arroyo Boulevard, York Boulevard, Monterey Road, Fremont Avenue, Alhambra Road, Garfield Avenue, Main Street, Las Tunas Drive, Live Oak Avenue, Myrtle Avenue, Duarte Road, Mountain Avenue, Foothill Boulevard, Santa Anita Avenue, Sierra Madre Boulevard, Washington Boulevard, Altadena Drive, Lake Avenue, Loma Alta Drive to point of beginning.

Anaheim Service Area

The Anaheim Service Area is that portion of the City of Anaheim, the City of Garden Grove, the City of Orange and Orange County that is bounded as follows: On the north by Lincoln Avenue, on the west by Brookhurst Street, on the south by Chapman Avenue and on the east by the Santa Ana River; all streets, inclusive.

Commencing from the Villa Del Sol, 305 North Harbor Boulevard, Fullerton via the most direct and appropriate route to the Orange County Airport.

V. INTER-AIRPORT OPERATIONS*Route 1 - Orange County Airport - Long Beach Municipal Airport via
Huntington Beach - Seal Beach

Commencing at Orange County Airport, MacArthur Boulevard, Campus Drive, Palisades Road, Newport Freeway, Pacific Coast Highway to Sheraton Beach Inn, 21112 Ocean Avenue, Huntington Beach, continuing along Pacific Coast Highway, Beach Boulevard, San Diego Freeway, Leisure World, 13533 Seal Beach Boulevard, San Diego Freeway, Long Beach Service Area and by the most direct and appropriate route to the Long Beach Municipal Airport.

Alternate Route 1 - Long Beach Service Area

Commencing at Orange County Airport, MacArthur Boulevard, San Diego Freeway and to the Long Beach Service Area.

Alternate Route 2 - Redhill Street

Between Orange County Airport and the Sheraton Beach Inn, Huntington Beach via MacArthur Boulevard Campus Drive, Palisades Road, Redhill Street, Baker Street, Harbor Boulevard, Adams Street and Beach Boulevard.

Alternate Route 3 - Main Street

Commencing at Sheraton Beach Inn, Ocean Avenue, Huntington Beach, west on Pacific Coast Highway, Main Street and to Beach Boulevard.

Alternate Route 4 - Seal Beach

Commencing from Sheraton Beach Inn, Huntington Beach, west on Pacific Coast Highway, north on Seal Beach Boulevard and to Leisure World, Seal Beach.

*Alternate Route - Los Angeles International Airport - Mission Viejo - Laguna Hills

Commencing at the Hilton Inn, 25205 La Paz Road, Mission Viejo, Santa Ana Freeway, El Toro Road, Avenue de la Carlota, Hyatt Laguna Hills Motel, 23932 Paseo de Valencia, Laguna Hills, continue on Paseo de Valencia, Avenue de la Carlota, El Toro Road, Interstate Highway 5 and over the most direct and appropriate route(s) to the Los Angeles International Airport.

Route 4 - Los Angeles International Airport - Lockheed Air Terminal - Long Beach Municipal Airport - Orange County Airport via Long Beach Service Area - Huntington Beach - Seal Beach

Commencing at Orange County Airport to Long Beach Service Area, Long Beach Municipal Airport along Route 1 and alternate Routes 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 described on Original Pages 13 and 14 of Appendix A and to Los Angeles International Airport and to Lockheed Air Terminal via Route 1 and alternate Routes 1, 2 and 3 described on Original Pages 8 and 9 of Appendix A.

Route 5 - Orange County Airport - Ontario International Airport

Between Orange County Airport and Ontario International Airport via the most direct and appropriate route.

Alternate Route - Anaheim Service Area - Fullerton

Commencing at Orange County Airport, via the most direct and appropriate route to: the Anaheim Service Area, Villa Del Sol, 305 North Harbor Boulevard, Fullerton, and to the airline passenger terminal at Ontario International Airport.

VI. OTHER OPERATIONS

Shuttle Service in Orange County

Supplementary shuttle service to connect with through service may be conducted between the Anaheim Service Area, on the one hand, and El Toro Marine Air Station, Newport Beach, Santa Ana, Orange, Fullerton or Buena Park, on the other hand, over any authorized route or combination of routes.

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
