SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 84644 issued today in Case No. 5432 (Petition for Modification No. 709) et al., the Commission found that "liquids, compressed gases and related commodities transported in trucks, trailers or semitrailers with carrier or shipper provided collapsible tanks or bags" should be reinstated in the lists of exempt commodities in Minimum Rate Tariffs 1-B, 2, 9-B and 19. The decision also provided that Minimum Rate Tariff 9-B should be amended by separate order to avoid duplication of tariff distribution.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff 9-B (Appendix A of Decision No. 67766, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective August 9, 1975, Fourteenth Revised Page 17, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

2. Tariff publications required to be made by common carriers as a result of this order shall be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order and may be made effective not earlier than the tenth day after the effective date of this order on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public and such

tariff publications shall be made effective not later than August 9, 1975; and tariff publications which are authorized but not required to be made by common carriers as a result of this order may be made effective not earlier than the tenth day after the effective date of this order, and may be made effective on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than sixty days after the effective date of the minimum rate tariff page incorporated in this order.


3. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the amendments authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 461.5 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the amendments published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.


4. In all other respects Decision No. 67766, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.

Rates in this tariff will not apply to shipments consisting of the following commodities:</p> <p>Accessories, motion picture Animals, live Automobiles, freight or passenger, set up (when rates are not otherwise provided in Minimum Rate Tariff 12) Baggage Carriers, used packages, empty, returning from an outbound paying load of traffic for which no rates are provided in this tariff, or forwarded for a return paying load of traffic for which no rates are provided in this tariff Concrete transported in motor vehicles equipped for mechanical mixing in transit Cotton, in bales Cotton Linters, in bales Film, motion picture Fruits, fresh or green, not cold pack nor frozen (when rates are not otherwise provided in Minimum Rate Tariff 8) Furniture, household appliances and other home furnishings transported from retail stores or retail store warehouses where they have been sold at retail by a retail merchant, or transported from retail customers to retail stores, or retail store warehouses Houses which have been disengaged from their foundations, or sections thereof and integral parts or contents when the contents are transported within the houses Liquids, compressed gases, commodities in semi-plastic form and commodities in suspension in liquids in bulk, in tank trucks, tank trailers, tank semitrailers or a combination of such highway vehicles.
