ORDER EXTENDING TIME

Applicant has requested an extension of time within which to exercise the authority granted in Decision No. 74076, alleging that construction of the project has been completed, but that the railroad has not yet installed the crossing protection. There are presently no trains running along the 6N Santa Ana Branch Line and it is contemplated that these tracks will either be abandoned by the railroad or the crossing protection will be constructed before any trains resume using this line. A decision will be reached by the railroad in the near future.

IT IS ORDERED that the time limit within which applicant may exercise the authority granted in said decision is hereby extended to April 1, 1977.


In all other respects Decision No. 74076 shall remain in full force and effect. The effective date of this order is the date hereof.
