ORDER EXTENDING TIME

Applicant having requested in writing on June 3, 1975, an extension of time through December 31, 1975, in which to comply with that portion of its certificate granted by Decision No. 77573 which relates to the construction and operation of a public utility radiotelephone system for service to the cities of Mt. Shasta, Weed, McCloud, and Dunsmuir and for which the Federal Communications Commission has not yet issued a construction permit, and it appearing to the Commission that an extension of time for compliance should be granted, therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the time for compliance with Ordering Paragraph 5 of Decision No. 77573 is extended to and including December 31, 1975.

In all other respects, Decision No. 77573 shall remain in full force and effect.
