ORDER AMENDING DECISION NO. 84595

Decision No. 84595 dated June 24, 1975 in Applications Nos. 54182 and 54315 granted in lieu highway common carrier certificates to Applegate Drayage Company, Inc., and Edward L. Heston, doing business as Heston Trucking Co. Ordering Paragraph 5(c) of the decision states that tariff filings shall be made effective not earlier than 30 days after the effective date of the order on not less than 30 days' notice to the Commission and the public, and the effective date of the tariff filings shall be concurrent with the establishment of the authorized service. The effective date of the order is July 14, 1975.

By letter dated July 8, 1975, Applegate requests that Ordering Paragraph 5(c), as it applies to it, be amended to authorize it to publish and file tariffs on five days' notice. The letter states that Applegate's customers require the authorized service as soon as possible; that it has been ready for some time to provide this service; and that the necessary tariff filings have been prepared. By letter dated July 14, 1975, Heston requests similar authority and has set forth similar justification therefor.

We find that the requested amendment is in the public interest and conclude that it should be granted.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Ordering Paragraph 5(c) of Decision No. 84595 is amended to read as follows:




5(c) The tariff filings shall be made effective not earlier than five days after the effective date of this order on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public, and the effective date of the tariff filings shall be concurrent with the establishment of the authorized service.

2. In all other respects, Decision No. 84595 shall remain in full force and effect.
