ORDER EXTENDING TIME

Decision No. 84334 by Ordering Paragraph 5 required that each water utility file a tariff sheet modifying its Rule 15, Main Extensions, sixty days after the effective date of the order, which became effective on July 5, 1975. All utilities are to file by September 4, 1975.

Because so many small companies are requesting assistance for this filing, our staff has informed us that more time is required to develop and mail the requested information. It appears to the Commission that an extension of time is reasonable and should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Ordering Paragraph 5 of Decision No. 84334 is modified to read as follows:

- "5. Within one hundred and twenty days after the effective date of this order each water utility in California subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission, except those which supply water primarily for irrigation uses, shall file, in accordance with the procedure prescribed by General Order No. 96-A, a tariff sheet substantially as set forth in Appendix B attached to this order."

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.
