SUPPLEMENTAL INTERIM OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 84591, dated June 24, 1975, in Case No. 5432 (Petition for Modification No. 771) established reduced incentive-oriented rates in the Commission's Minimum Rate Tariff 2 (MRT 2) for the transportation of lumber and forest products for an experimental period expiring with June 30, 1976.

It has been brought to the Commission's attention that the aforementioned rates were not adjusted to reflect the intent of Decision No. 84591.

At the time California Trucking Association filed its amended petition dated February 7, 1975, in this proceeding, the existing charges determined under MRT 2 were subject to a 6 percent surcharge and it was intended that the then proposed reduced rates on lumber and forest products would also be subject to said surcharge. By Decision No. 84539 the rates in MRT 2 were adjusted effective July 14, 1975, and the surcharge was concurrently cancelled. The reduced rates on lumber were established effective July 26, 1975, but such rates were not adjusted to offset the effect of the surcharge which had been cancelled.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that the necessary corrections should be made by the order herein. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that MRT 2 should be amended accordingly.

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Minimum Rate Tariff 2 (Appendix D of Decision No. 31606, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective September 6, 1975, Twenty-third Revised Page 51-CC, Ninth Revised Page 51-CCC and Twenty-seventh Revised Page 51-DD attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
- 2. Tariff publications required to be made by common carriers as a result of this order shall be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order and may be made effective not earlier than the first day after the effective date of this order on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and to the public and shall be made effective not later than September 6, 1975.
- 3. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the rates authorized by this order, are authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 461.5 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures not maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the rates published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof unless, before such effective date, there shall have been filed with the Commission written response to this order requesting public hearing in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
