ORDER EXTENDING STAY
OF DECISION NO. 84485

On June 3, 1975 the Commission issued Decision No. 84485. The effective date of said decision was June 23, 1975. On June 3, 1975 Pacific Gas and Electric Company and Southern California Edison Company filed separate petitions for rehearing of Decision No. 84485. Since the petitions for rehearing were filed ten days before the effective date of Decision No. 84485, the decision was stayed.
