ORDER EXTENDING TIME

Astro Air Express, Inc. (Astro), by letter of August 7, 1975, has requested an extension of time in which to comply with those provisions of Ordering Paragraph 2 of Decision No. 84268, wherein Astro was required to establish the authorized service and file tariffs within one hundred and twenty days after the effective date of the order.

Astro explains that the proposal that "Applicant proposes rates, rules, and regulations, which are generally competitive with Emery Air Freight Corporation..." was understood to indicate the form of tariff to be filed, not the level of rates.

The Transportation Division recommends that the requested extension of time be granted.

After consideration the Commission finds that the requested extension of time is reasonable and should be granted, therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the time limit for compliance with the provisions of Ordering Paragraph 2(b), (c), and (d) shall be extended to December 31, 1975.
