ORDER OF DISMISSAL

By these petitions, Southwest Gas Corporation (petitioner) requests a modification of Decision No. 78498 to track, through filings made under the advice letter procedure, any cost of gas increases in Pacific Gas and Electric Company's (PG&E) Rate Schedule G-62 resulting from Commission action granting to PG&E all or part of the rate relief sought by PG&E in its Applications Nos. 55510, 55661 and 55687.

In Decision No. 84603 dated July 1, 1975, Southwest Gas Corporation was authorized to file a revised Preliminary Statement providing for a purchased gas adjustment clause in its tariffs which filing will obviate the necessity for the ninth, tenth and eleventh petitions for modification of order contained in Decision No. 78498.

By letter dated July 24, 1975 Southwest Gas had requested dismissal of the ninth, tenth and eleventh petitions for modification of Decision No. 78498.

GOOD CAUSE APPEARING, IT IS ORDERED that:

The ninth, tenth and eleventh petitions for modification of Decision No. 78498 filed as Application No. 52428 are dismissed without prejudice.
