Application of the State of California, Department of Transportation, for an order authorizing the construction of West Visalia Overhead and South Plaza Underpass over and under the Southern Pacific Transportation Company's El Paso Route and mainline track and one future track on the west, in connection with the reconstruction of Route 99, Route 198 Interchange on new alignment, four miles west of Visalia, in the County of Tulare.

OPINION

The State of California, Department of Transportation, in connection with the reconstruction of the Route 99/198 Interchange and related work, four miles west of the City of Visalia in Tulere County, requests authority to construct two new crossings at separated grades, to be known as the West Visalia Overhead and the South Plaza Underpass, over and under the tracks of the Southern Pacific Transportation Company's El Paso Route.

The California Highway Commission is the lead agency for this project pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970, as amended. After consideration of a Negative Declaration, the California Highway Commission approved the project to reconstruct the Route 99/198 Interchange and related work, and on June 20, 1974 filed a Notice of Determination with the Secretary for Resources which found that "The project will not have a significant effect on the environment."

Notice of the application was published in the Commission's Daily Calendar on April 25, 1975. No protests have been received. A public hearing is not necessary.
