ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision No. 83139 dated July 16, 1974, in Application No. 54527, Rasara, Inc., a corporation, was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation between points within the City of Antioch and between points in Antioch, on the one hand, and the BART Station at Concord, Bethel Island, Knightsen, Brentwood "Loop" and various industrial plants east and west of Antioch, on the other hand.

Upon written request of the applicant, the Commission, by Decision No. 83455, extended the time to file a written acceptance of the certificate granted until December 16, 1974. On October 22, 1974 the Commission received another written request for a further extension of time to comply with Ordering Paragraphs 2(a) and 2(b) of Decision No. 83139. By Decision No. 83711, the request was granted to extend the time until April 12, 1975 to file a written acceptance of the certificate and until May 12, 1975 to commence the authorized service and file tariffs and timetables.

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Applicant has not filed a written acceptance of the certificate granted nor has it filed any tariffs and timetables within the extended time allowed. Applicant has also not filed a request for a further extension of time.

Since July 16, 1974, Rasara, Inc. has had no evidence of insurance on file with this Commission showing adequate protection against liability imposed by law for payment of damage for personal injury or property damage, as required by General Order No. 101-C.

It appears and the Commission finds that these matters constitute good cause for the revocation of the aforementioned certificate and that such revocation would not be adverse to the public interest. The Commission, therefore, concludes that the certificate should be revoked.

IT IS ORDERED that the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity in the name of Rasara, Inc., a corporation, to operate as a passenger stage corporation between points within the City of Antioch and between points in Antioch, on the one hand, and the BART Station at Concord, Bethel Island, Knightsen, Brentwood "Loop" and various industrial plants east and west of Antioch, on the other hand, authorized by Decision No. 83139 in Application No. 54527, is hereby revoked upon the effective date of this order.





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hearing, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.


