## OPI:TIO: AND ORDER

Souza's Milk Transportation Co., a corporation, operates as a hishway pernit carrier. By this application, it seeks authomity to deviate from the minfmum rates in Minfmum Rate Tariff 2 (MRT 2) In connection with the transportation of dairy products and related articles for Foremost Foods Company (Foremost). Applicant requests ex parte action in this matter or interim relief in the event that a bearing is deemed necessary.

Applicant, since August; 1 ; 1974, has been transporting shipments of dairy products and related articles under refrigeration for Forenost from its Fresno plant facility to its various distributors in Bakersfield, Coalinga, Delano, Hanford, Lemoore, tulare and Visaila on a weekiy schedule of five days per week, Friday and Saturday excepted.

Foremost has informed applicant that the rates and charges set forth in MRT 2 for the movement of its products between Fresno and its distribution points do not allow it to be competitive with other producers of dairy products who resort to proprietary operations or the use of camiers who hold deviation authority or other arrangements.

Applicant proposes truckioad d土stance rates on mixed shipments of datry products subject to MRT 2, as well as dairy products exempt from minimum rates as provided in Items 41 and 42 of MRY 2, from Fresno to Foremost's distributors Iocated in Bakersifeld, Coalinga, Delano, Hanford, Lemoore, Tulare and Visalia with split delivery privileges.

Applicant sets forth in Exhibits $B, C$ and $D$ of the application its direct labor costs, vehicie fixed expense, and running costs respectively. With these costs and expenses, it has calculated the direct cost per tilp and the estimated revenue per shipment based on the proposed rates with split delivery charges inciaded for varlous mileages. Applicant alleges that the overall operating ratio for various shipments at various minfoum weights would be 81.41 percent. Exhioit $F$, Statement of Income Nine Months Ended September 30, 1974, shows a favorable operating ratio of 86.66 percent.

Copy of the appilcation was malled to Califomia rucking Association on or about July 1 , 1975. The appifcation was IIstec on the Commission's Daily Calendar of July 3, 1975. No objection to the granting of the appization has been received.

The Comission finds that applicant's proposal is reasonable and conciudes that the appilcation should be granted as set forth in the ensuing order. Since the conditions under which service is performed may change at any time, the authority granted in the ensuing order will be made to explre at the end of one year unless sooner cancelied, changed of extended by order of the Commssion.

IT IS ORDERED that:
i. Souza's M1Jk Iransporation Co., a corporation, is author1zed to transport dairy products and related products for Foremost Foods Company from the Foremost Fresno plant facility to Foremost
distributors located in Bakersfield, Coalinga, Delano, Hanford, Lemoore, Iulare and Visaila at rates less than the appilcable minImum rates and charges, but not less than the rates and charges set forth in Appendix $A$, attached hereto and by this reference made a part bereof.
2. In all other respects, the provisions of Minimum Rate Taniff 2 shall apply.
3. The authomity granted herein shall expire one year after the effective date of this order unless sooner modified.
