ORDER GRANTING REHEARING

On January 23, 1975, Greyhound Lines, Inc. (Greyhound) filed an application for a labor cost offset increase in fares and express rates in the amount of \$1,090,000. Greyhound indicated that this amount would restore the 10.5 percent rate of return previously authorized by Decision No. 83777. 1

On July 29, 1975, the Commission issued Decision No. 84717 granting Greyhound a two percent increase in local commute and suburban fares. This increase will generate an estimated \$94,000 in additional annual revenue and yield a 9.2 percent rate of return. On August 6, 1975, Greyhound petitioned for rehearing of Decision No. 84717.

Having fully reviewed this petition, we are persuaded that good cause for rehearing of Decision No. 84717 has been made to appear.

Decision No. 83777 issued on November 26, 1974 granted Greyhound a general rate increase and an allowable rate of return of 10.5 percent.
