ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Hearing on this complaint by Scott-Buttner Communications, Inc. against The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company with regard to the reasonableness of rate charges for the SG-1 PBX System service was held before Examiner Coffey on December 19, 1974 in San Francisco.

After one day of direct testimony by complainant who alleged Pacific's authorized rates are not cost supportable, this matter was removed from the calendar at the request of both parties. On February 28, 1975 Pacific filed Application No. 55527 requesting an increase in tariff rates for SG-1 PBX System service.

Since complainant had petitioned that further hearing on its complaint be consolidated with Application No. 55527 and the parties had indicated their readiness, hearings on these matters were set for September 10, 1975.

By letter dated September 5, 1975, complainant requested that Case No. 9737 be dismissed without prejudice since it will participate in Application No. 55527 as an interested party.

IT IS ORDERED that the complaint in Case No. 9737 is dismissed without prejudice.
