ORDER DENYING REHEARING

By the filing of this application, PSA sought authority to conduct nonstop passenger air carrier operations between San Diego International Airport (SAN) and San Jose Municipal Airport (SJC). After public hearings, the issuance of a proposed report, and the filing of exceptions thereto, Decision No. 84769 was issued, in which PSA's requested authority was denied.

On August 21, 1975, PSA filed a petition for rehearing of Decision No. 84769. In Accordance with Section 1733 of the Public Utilities Code, the filing of PSA's petition for rehearing suspended the operation of Decision No. 84769, pending consideration of the petition for rehearing.

Having now fully reviewed each and every allegation of the petition for rehearing, we are persuaded that good cause for rehearing of Decision No. 84769 has not been made to appear.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:






1. Rehearing of Decision No. 84769 is hereby denied.
