ORDER DENYING RECONSIDERATION

In a complaint filed on July 30, 1975, complainant herein alleged that Defendant Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) has performed, and will perform numerous acts in conflict with complainant's aspirations with regard to the Nuclear Safeguards initiative which is to be before the voters on June 8, 1976. Complainant has sought both immediate and permanent relief by way of the issuance of an order enjoining PG&E from engaging in these alleged acts allegedly at the expense of the ratepayers.

In Decision No. 84766, we denied complainant's request for immediate ex parte relief, but expressly reserved ruling on the validity or merits of the complaint.

On August 15, 1975, complainant filed a petition for reconsideration of Decision No. 84766. Having reviewed each and every allegation in this petition, we are persuaded that good cause for reconsideration of Decision No. 84766 has not been shown. Accordingly, we will deny reconsideration of Decision No. 84766. This


denial, however, should not be construed as a ruling on the validity or merits of the complaint.


IT IS ORDERED that reconsideration of Decision No. 84766 is hereby denied.
