OPINION

The Southern Pacific Transportation Company requests authority to construct an industrial spur track at grade across North Argyle Avenue in the City of Fresno, Fresno County.

The proposed construction lies within an established industrial manufacturing area. The industry to be served is in need of immediate rail service and applicant has, therefore, requested that the usual 20-day waiting period be waived.

Notice of the application was published in the Commission's Daily Calendar on May 7, 1975. No protests have been received. A public hearing is not necessary.

FINDINCS

After consideration, the Commission finds:

- 1. Applicant should be authorized to construct an industrial spur track at grade across North Argyle Avenue in the City of Fresno, Fresno County, at the location and substantially as shown by plans attached to the application.
- 2. Costs of constructing the crossing should be borne by the applicant.
- 3. It can be seen with reasonable certainty that this project will not have a significant effect on the environment.

This authorization shall expire if not exercised within two years unless time be extended or if the above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.
