OPINION

Santa Paula Water Works, Ltd. seeks authority to issue a \$170,000 note in accordance with a Term Loan Agreement.

Applicant is a California corporation operating a public utility water system in Santa Paula and vicinity. For the year 1974 it reported operating revenues of \$499,668 and net income of \$30,918.

As authorized by Decisions Nos. 83282, dated August 6, 1974, 84276, dated April 1, 1975, and 84503, dated June 3, 1975, applicant herein has outstanding promissory notes aggregating \$170,000 in favor of Security Pacific National Bank. The utility proposes to retire said outstanding notes by issuing a new note pursuant to a Term Loan Agreement in the principal amount of \$170,000 repayable in quarterly installments of \$6,071.40, and bearing interest at a rate of at least 3% per annum, but not exceeding 2-1/2% per annum in excess of Security Pacific National Bank's prime rate, as such prime rate may change from time to time.

After consideration the Commission finds that: (1) the proposed note would be for a proper purpose; (2) the money, property or labor to be procured or paid for by the note herein authorized is reasonably required for the purpose specified herein; and (3) such purpose is not, in whole or in part, reasonably chargeable to operating expenses or to income.
