## OPINION

Santa Paula Water Works, Ltd., a corporation, by the aboveentitled application filed August 11, 1975, and letter received
September 16, 1975, seeks authorization of this Commission to carry
out the terms of an agreement with Robert O. Boswell and
Patricia E. Boswell permitting them to take not to exceed 65,340
cubic feet of water per year, but not in excess of 179 cubic feet of
water in any 24-hour period, of surface flow from Santa Paula Creek
for garden purposes. The price to be paid for the right to take
water is \$45.31 per year and excess water taken will be charged at
the maximum consumption block of General Metered Service, Tariff
Rate Schedule No. 1. The terms of the agreement provide that it is
to remain in effect from year to year until terminated by either
party, subject to modification by this Commission.

An agreement for the same purpose was approved by the Commission in its Decision No. 57933, dated January 20, 1959, in Application No. 40652 for the Whitelaws, prior occupants of the Boswell property.

The Commission having considered the request of applicant is of the opinion that the application should be granted and that a public hearing is not necessary;

## ORDER

## IT IS ORDERED that:

- l. Santa Paula Water Works, Ltd., is authorized to carry out the terms and conditions of the agreement with Robert O. Boswell and Patricia E. Boswell, as set forth in Exhibit A attached to this application as modified by the aforementioned letter.
- 2. Applicant shall file with this Commission within thirty days after the effective date of this order two certified copies of the agreement as executed together with a statement of the date on which the agreement is deemed to have become effective.
- 3. Applicant shall notify this Commission of the date of termination of said agreement within thirty days after the date of termination.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
