ORDER EXTENDING TIME

By Decision No. 84687 dated July 22, 1975 Rossi Transportation, Inc. was ordered to collect undercharges in the amount of \$3,181.10 and to pay a fine in said amount plus a punitive fine in the amount of \$500. As of August 19, 1975, \$2,104.13 in undercharges and fines had been collected and paid to the Commission including 25 percent of the amount assessed to respondent Alvin Standley. Because respondent Alvin Standley is a small businessman and because of the depressed economic condition of the lumber industry, it is requested that he be permitted to pay the balance of \$1,576.97 in the following installments:




IT IS ORDERED that time to collect undercharges and pay fines in compliance with Decision No. 84687 is hereby extended as requested.
